8 th. Kardamili International Jazz Festival

is hosted by Sarpsborg Jazz Club in Norway, in cooperation with New Orleans Workshop, Asker Jazz Club, Apollo and View Travel

Kardamili is a small charming village with about 400 inhabitants, located in Mani south of Kalamata in Peloponnese, Greece. 76 concerts are free of charge, but we appreciate donations. The hat will go around ("kitty") at the concerts.

Will be open from may 10. Here you can buy festival T shirts, posters, tickets for Blues Cruise, bus ticket for Kalamata for the concert in Kytaro Rock Bar and pick up programs. Opening hours during the festival: 10-14 and 18-19

Bus to Kalamata Friday may 20 at 17:00 from Plateia

Since we have a concert at Kytaro Rock Bar in Kalamata, there will be a bus from Plateia at 17:00 and the bus will return at 23:30 from Kalamata. The bus cost 15 € and you buy the ticket at the festival office in advance. If available space, you just show up at the Plateia.

Blues Cruise in the Messinian Bay on the boat Albatros with Reidar Larsen Blues Band Wednesday may 25.

The boat departure from the harbour in Stoupa at 10:00 and will return around 15:00. Ticket costs 60 € and it includes bus from Kardamili (in Plateia at 09:30) and lunch.
